MoUs/Agreements signed during the State Visit of President of France to India

India - France relations

France and India enjoy an exceptionally warm relationship based on reinforced trust between the two countries. In the economic field, trade relations have developed over the years and bilateral trade has increased significantly over the past decade; it has almost doubled from USD 6.2 billion in 2006-07 to USD 11 billion in 2016-17. Further, the trade imbalance is gradually reducing in favour of India from a trade deficit of USD 2.2 billion in 2006-07 to USD 0.4 billion in 2016-17.

More than the volume of bilateral trade, the dynamism of Indo-French economic relations springs from the establishment of French companies in India. Presently, more than 1000 French subsidiaries from a wide spectrum of sectors are present in India and employ a workforce of around 3,00,000 persons. France is the 9th biggest investor in India, wherein it has invested around USD 6.2 billion during 2000-17.
