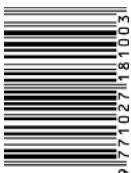

NS30-M ICT FOR EDUCATION MINISTRY

The Ministry of Education, Arts & Culture's revamped website currently lists the awards of three high value Open National Bidding tenders for ICT supplies that had closed in January.

The ministry had invited reputable and experienced service providers to bid for the ONB tenders, but only posted the tender notices on its website on 29-Nov-23 – in apparent contravention of the Public Procurement Act which stipulates the preferred procurement method is Open Advertised Bidding which means that tender notices should be placed in local newspapers with a wide circulation.

The *Tender Bulletin* found these invitations to bid - dated 24-Nov-23 - on the MEAC website on 29-Nov-23 and listed them in *Bulletin 1520*.

In June this year, the ministry suddenly started posting requests for quotations on its website, resulting in a flood of small value bids on short notice periods.

1,600 desktops, 40 laptops, 40 printers and anti virus software

NS183-M SCHOOL FEEDING TENDER REGURGITATED

21 JUNE 2024

On 15-May-24 the Central Procurement Board announced the re-award of a tender awarded in 2022 that had been issued in 2020, merely stating that: "This Notice of Award follows the order of the Supreme Court Case No. SA43/2022".

Although the notice published in *New Era* of 24-May-24 says "For more details, please log on to: www.cpbm.com.na" no further details could be found on the CPB's website to explain why the same companies from 2022 were again successful, with the same prices they had offered three years ago when the tender first closed.

On 04-Mar-22 *Tender Bulletin 1435* already listed the award of tender G/ONB/CPBN-04/2020 for the provision of protein, sugar, salt and transportation to blenders warehouses on behalf of the education ministry's school feeding programme that finally closed on 16-Feb-21 after several extensions. The total amount of the award to eight companies came to N\$183-m - much more than the N\$102-m CPB cost estimate. All 32 offers from N\$120-m to N\$290-m over three years were published in *Bulletin 1395*.

The CPB's latest re-award notice lists the same eight tenderers that it awarded the tender to as posted on its website on 24-Jan-22, with regions awarded and prices for the three-year period:

- * Padana Investment - Lots 5 (Kavango West) & 11 (Oshana) = N\$32,129,463.67
- * Sash Trading & Earthworks - Lots 8 (Ohangwena) & 10 (Omusati) = N\$55,315,306.69
- * Tafina Trading - Lot 4 (Kavango East) = N\$21,195,655.65

As a result of a Supreme Court order, the Central Procurement Board is justified in disqualifying some of the bidders and re-awards its 2020 tender for blending protein, sugar and salt to regional warehouses for the education ministry's school feeding programme to the original eight suppliers at the same prices as before, totaling N\$183-m

The total prices for all 14 regions add up to N\$182,976,694.44 including VAT - much more than the cost estimate of N\$102,192,025.74.

Tender G/ONB/CPBN-04/2020 for the provision of protein, sugar, salt and transportation to blenders warehouses closed on 16-Feb-21 after it had been extended from 23-Nov-20 to 07-Dec-20 as well as 18-Jan-21.

Only five of the 32 bidders had participated in the earlier 2013 tender, with many of the remaining 27 operating as general traders (*Bulletin 1435 - 'School feeding free-for-all'*).

The court case

Supreme Court Case No. SA43/2022 (above) refers to the matter between the chairperson of the Review Panel, the CPB chairperson and the Central Procurement Board as appellants and Stream Two Properties cc as respondent that was heard on 17-Jul-23. Judgement was delivered on 15-Dec-23 that the appeal against an earlier High Court decision setting aside the Review Panel's ruling was successful.

During the evaluation process tenderer Stream Two was asked by the CPB to provide the full birth certificate of its sole member.

Stream Two's bid was subsequently deemed unresponsive by the CPB because of a perceived conflict of interest, since the sole member of Stream Two, Herman Ando Nekomba, shared the same surname, physical and postal addresses with the members of two other bidders, Degrande Investments and Degree Power Investment.

The Review Panel set aside this disqualification by the CPB of Stream Two and directed the Board to reconsider the bid and if a conflict of interest was indeed found to exist, the CPB may disqualify Stream Two.

The matter landed in the High Court on judicial review and found that the Review Panel had exceeded its authority to seek additional reasons for Stream Two's disqualification beyond those initially provided by the CPB.

The High Court ordered the CPB to consider Stream Two's bid, which was appealed against in the Supreme Court. The Supreme Court then set aside the High Court's order, ruling in favour of the appellants with costs.

This disputed tender was issued in conjunction with another invitation for the MEAC's School Feeding Programme, G/ONB/CPBN-03/2020 for the provision of maize meal blending, packaging and transportation to regional distributors' warehouses that closed on 15-Feb-21, after being extended from 23-Nov-20 to 07-Dec-20 as well as 18-Jan-21.

Twenty-two offers ranging from N\$168-m to N\$328-m over three years were published in *Bulletin 1391*.

This tender was awarded to five companies for N\$188-m - way below the CPB's N\$286-m cost estimate and also became the subject of court litigation involving the same bidders.

The November tender notice called for pre-qualification offers for the second phase of the construction of an extension to the Katima Mulilo Campus. The Project name is: Expansion of the UNAM Extension of the Katima Mulilo Campus with BMZ ID number 2019674395 and KfW procurement number 510233.

UNAM has received a grant from the German Government within the framework of German Financial Cooperation with Namibia via the KfW Development Bank. The University intends to use part of this grant to finance the second phase of the construction of the UNAM campus for the 'Department for Wildlife Management & Ecotourism' in Katima Mulilo. Independent construction firms

wishing to act as general contractor for this project were invited to submit their applications for pre-qualification for the construction services, guided by the latest version of the KfW 'Guidelines for the Procurement of Consulting Services, Works, Plant, Goods and Non-Consulting Services in Financial Co-operation with Partner Countries'.

EISH, SHAMPUMBA STRIKES AGAIN

21 JUNE 2024

The Ministry of Sport, Youth & National Services will pay over N\$10.8-m annually to influential northern businessman and property mogul, Erastus 'Chicco' Shapumba, to rent his new building in Windhoek's central business district, with another report stating that the ministry will pay N\$1-m per month over the next three years.

According to insiders, tender procedures and processes were allegedly flouted to push the deal through.

The youth ministry's executive director, Erastus Haitengela, said they were currently paying N\$450,000 a month to the Namibia Industrial Development Agency for office space, amounting to N\$5.4-m a year. Some of the youth ministry's staff are accommodated at the Ministry of Education, Arts & Culture's Government Office Park offices, while others are located at the Katutura Community Arts Centre. Lease of the new building would allow all the ministry's staff to work in one location, improving efficiency and accountability, he added.

According to Haitengela, the youth would now be easier able to visit the new headquarters, where they can use free Wi-Fi and printing services. He said the current premises at NIDA had limited toilet facilities and poor ventilation.

The amount quoted for renting office space was in line with what the Ministry of Works & Transport allows per square metre in the CBD Haitengela emphasised. There were still technical issues to be resolved and the ministry might only move into the new building towards the second half of the year.

The new premises on Independence Avenue opposite NamPost are currently undergoing renovations. Concerns have been raised about high parking fees and insufficient space for busses in the CBD.

Flagrant waste of taxpayer's money

Popular Democratic Movement parliamentarian, Maximilian Katjijune, criticized the decision as a flagrant waste of taxpayer's money, "especially when one considers that hundreds of millions of workers worldwide work remotely due to the advancement of technology". The money now to be paid by the ministry could have been prioritized for the renovation of dilapidated youth centres and sport facilities.

The Landless People's Movement youth command leader, Duminga Ndala, also said moving to the new building was unwarranted, particularly in view of the ministry's shortcomings in addressing the socio-economic status of young people. Priority should be given to programmes and initiatives geared towards youth empowerment and advancement.

Parliamentarian Inna Hengari commented that the sharp rise in the youth ministry's rental fees from N\$3.2-m in the 2022/23 financial year to N\$5-m in 2023/24 was expected to increase to N\$6.2-m during 2024/25, indicating a lack of prudent financial management. Such a substantial increase could have been avoided through alternative cost saving measures or negotiating better lease terms, she said (*New Era 25-Apr-24; The Namibian 14-May-24*).

No public tender was issued by the youth ministry for renting office space in Windhoek.

Information Ministry moves to Shapumba Building

The Ministry of Information & Communication Technology's Procurement Management Unit recently issued tender NCS/RFQ/29-02/2024 calling for 2x 5-ton trucks and 12x labourers to assist the ministry's relocation from its current premises at Parliament Garden, First City Centre and BPI House to Trust Building and from the Government Information Centre to Shapumba Building over 21 days.

The tender closed on 15-Apr-24 and

The northern business mogul scores two more lucrative property deals with the government, as the information and youth ministries enter into lease agreements with 'Chicco' Shapumba – without public tenders. The N\$1-m monthly rental for the youth ministry's new building in Windhoek's CBD is more than double the N\$450,000 it is currently paying the Namibia Industrial Development Agency for premises in the capital

was listed in *Tender Bulletin 1535*.

Again no public tenders were called by MICT calling for suitable office space. The rental amount for this deal is unknown.

'Don't give tenders to the politically connected'

The name of Erastus Shapumba of the CHICO Group of Companies keeps cropping up in the media with regards to questionable property deals, often involving government ministries or agencies. He is the President of Namibia Local Business Association formed in 2022.

According to Google, Chicco Shapumba is one of the richest people in Namibia and a well-known sponsor of the Sam Nujoma Foundation, Oshakati Totem Expo and other projects close to the ruling party.

In 2018 he ironically appealed to public officials not to award government tenders to entrepreneurs on the basis of political connections. He made the request during a lecture he gave at the 'Night of Inspiration' organised by the Sem Shivute Foundation during the Ongwediva Trade Fair.

While Namibia had good leadership and laws, many administrators allocate government tenders "on a favouritism basis and without consideration that the national cake needs to be fairly distributed," Shapumba warned at the time. He said public tenders were mostly granted to politically well-connected entrepreneurs, including those lacking the capacity or who had previously failed to succeed.

He wanted government work to be awarded without discrimination and without considering political affiliation or connections.

"Namibia will remain a good country if government officials exercise fairness and refrain from corruption when carrying out their civic responsibility," he said (*New Era 05-Sep-18; Tender Bulletin 1269*).

Oshakati town council sold N\$30-m property to Shapumba for N\$2.5-m

Bulletin 1172 reported in 2016 that then Minister of Urban & Rural Development, Sophia Shaningwa, summoned the CEO of the Oshakati Municipality, Werner Iita, mayor Katrina Shimbulu and five town councilors to explain the sale of a hotly contested 1.7ha piece of prime land known as Omatala Market for a mere N\$2.5-m to Mouse Properties, a company owned by Erastus 'Chicco' Shapumba.

An independent valuator had valued Erf 1342 (which used to be the Oshakati Open Market) at N\$30-m and recommended it should not be sold for below N\$17-m or above N\$47-m.

According to the Town Council Land Committee's score sheet, Mouse Properties scored only 57.13% and was ranked fourth among the 11 companies that had submitted bids.

The deal followed an expression of interest closing on 31-Oct-14 where the Oshakati Town Council asked for proposals for a concept design and development plan for Erf 1342, Extension 4 along main road M92 in Oshakati.

In 2022 Shapumba won a court battle against the Oshakati town council over the acquisition of the old open market. According to court documents, Shapumba's company paid the money to the council before ministerial consent was sought to buy the erf as prescribed by law. The council then resolved it would first seek MURD's written advice

regarding its intention to restart the process of disposing of Erf 1342.

In 2021 the town council resolved to refund Mouse Properties for the land, resulting in Shapumba's court challenge to force through the N\$2.5-m deal (*New Era 22-Apr-22*).

Boasting of his business acumen

Before the Oshakati property tender deadline, "building material mogul" Shapumba boasted in a two-page advertorial in the weekly newspaper *Confidante* about the 'world class facility' his company intended to build at the old Oshakati Market and listed other property developments he had embarked upon since he entered business in 1995.

His business has expanded to 24 stores in building supplies, 12 long-haul trucks to convey building materials from neighbouring countries, and three farms.

Shapumba also listed several personal awards he received "due to his divinity in business, dedication and hard work towards the social and economic challenges facing the Namibian society". These include the 2008 Laureate of the Namibia Business Hall of Fame junior achievement; 2009 NCCI Best Business Personality of the Year; 2010 NCCI Best Business Entrepreneur of the Year and 2012 NCCI Northern Branch Best Infrastructure Development & Capital Assets.

Some of the infrastructure projects he embarked upon in Windhoek include Shapumba Towers in Gutenberg Street (valued at N\$49-m), Erf 112 and 113 in Schleswig & Van Rensburg Street in Lafrenz (N\$26.1-m), Erf 3583 in Luderitz Street in the CBD (N\$42.1-m), Erf 209 in Lafrenz Ext. 1 used by AMTA (N\$23.8-m) and Erf 1153 in Mont Blanc Street (N\$3.5-m).

In northern Namibia he has developed two complexes in Omuthiya, a building next to FNB in Ondangwa, Ongwediva New Mall in Ext. 11, 55 houses rented to UNAM, two complexes in Okahao and the CHICO head office in Oshakati.

Shapumba also announced his intention to establish the Erastus Shapumba Foundation to complement government efforts in funding education for Namibian students (*Confidante 07-Jul-16*) - yet this foundation was already inaugurated by former president Pohamba in 2012 (*Tender Bulletin 1172*).

AMTA overpaid N\$27-m for Shapumba's property in Lafrenz

Tender Bulletin 1306 reported in 2019 that the management of the Agro Marketing & Trade Agency, headed by Lucas Lungameni, entered into 70 contracts worth over N\$50-m that were not approved by the AMTA board or the Ministry of Agriculture, Water & Forestry.

Of the 70 major contracts finalised by AMTA between 2014 and 2018 only 13 were approved by the board and three by the MAWF.

Some of the contracts not approved include the N\$2.6-m rental agreement for the AMTA head office in Windhoek, the purchase of a property in Windhoek's Northern Industrial Area for N\$46-m (registered as N\$40-m at the Deeds Office) from Shapumba, which was afterwards ratified by the board.

Shapumba had bought the erf from Trustco in 2013 for N\$4-m and sold it to the struggling parastatal in 2017 for N\$46-m. It was found that AMTA overpaid by as much as N\$27-m on this deal.

Oshikango warehouse a health hazard

AMTA was paying N\$1.6-m a year from 2015 to 2020 to rent a dilapidated warehouse in Oshikango - considered a health hazard - from Shapumba Tower Investment.

The agency hardly used the property and in November 2018 the AMTA board had been briefed that the building was in a shocking state and not suitable for fresh produce storage.

Shapumba denied any wrongdoing and insisted that the contract between him and AMTA was transparent, suggest that the agency was struggling to manage its business efficiently, while also complaining that "Namibians are lazy and just want to complain. They just want tenders."

AMTA board chairperson, Esther Kaapanda, quietly resigned in February 2019 after complaining about rampant financial irregularities at the agency. Kaapanda was one of the few board members who questioned why AMTA bosses were overpaying themselves and dragging the agency into dubious land deals.

Other reports in *The Namibian* referred to AMTA paying N\$57-m to Shapumba two transactions paid through his company Erf Two Zero Nine CC (27-Apr-23) and government paying N\$500,000 a month to rent a building in Windhoek from Shapumba to house veterans affairs (07-Jan-21).

Opuwo sports stadium sold without youth ministry's approval

New Era reported on 23-May-23 that the Opuwo town council had sold the government-owned historic Newman Katuta Stadium in the central business district for around N\$1.3-m to Shapumba - without the youth and sports ministry's knowledge or blessing.

It remains unclear how this deal was allowed to go through, in contravention of the State Finance Act.

According to Shapumba he acted in good faith during negotiations with the Opuwo Town Council, after a council resolution was passed in 2013 to sell the stadium to him. Shapumba claimed that when he bought the stadium it was not in use and in a dilapidated state.

He said the transaction was duly and properly authorised, devoid of any irregularity and executed with complete due compliance of all contractual obligations. Shapumba promised to develop a one-stop business centre on the land where the stadium is situated.

Before Shapumba commenced with what was thought to be a mega development, a gentleman's agreement was struck between the council and Shapumba in which the businessman would first have to build a stadium of the same quality on land allocated by the council.

Shapumba insisted that his sales agreement with the council did not include such a verbal agreement.

But the project never took off and Shapumba later sold the stadium to Opuwo-based businessman Gerrit Schoeman for about N\$5-m without adding any value.

Immediately after the acquisition of the disputed land, Shapumba transferred it to his own company, Okahao Sunshine CC, but then sold his interest to Schoeman.

The town council only learned about the transaction between Shapumba and Schoeman when the latter approached them for approval of his construction plans.

According to a statement issued by Shapumba, his company did the clearing and earthworks and Okahao Sunshine had delivered on the "undertaking as a new sports field has been erected and is currently being used for sporting events."
