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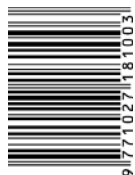

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## Plastering over the cracks

ALTHOUGH NAMIBIA'S CENTRAL GOVERNMENT HAS INCREASED ITS BUDGET FOR CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS BY AN UNPRECEDENTED 42% IN 2024/25, THE N\$3.2-B VOTED IS LOWER THAN IN EIGHT OF THE PAST TWELVE YEARS, ONLY HALF ITS N\$6.135-B PEAK EXPENDITURE IN 2015/16, WHILE THIS IS ALSO THE SECOND CONSECUTIVE YEAR THAT THE BUDGET FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION IS LESS THAN THAT FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES AS WELL AS FOR OTHER SERVICES AND EXPENSES - BOTH HEADS OF CONSUMPTION EXPENDITURE THAT DO NOT ADD VALUE - PAGE 2

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**N\$4.4-b has been voted for materials and supplies in 2024/25, accounting for the biggest, 32.8% of the N\$13.495-b procurement budget, following a N\$722.55-m or 19.6% increase on last year's revised N\$3.68-b expenditure when it accounted for 33.27% – also the biggest and ahead of construction's N\$2.2-b with only 20%.**

Although Namibia's central government has increased its procurement budget by 22% to a ten-year high of N\$13.5-b in 2024/25, the N\$3.2-b set aside for construction is only the fourth-highest in the past twelve years and only a little over half the N\$6.135-b spent on construction, renovations and improvements in 2015/16.

This is also the second consecutive year that the budget for construction is less than both the allocations for materials and supplies as well as for other services and expenses, both of which are heads of current expenditure mainly in the operational budget that do not add value.

As reported previously, this year's procurement budget includes a disappointing 4.34% decrease in the acquisition of operational equipment, machinery and plant to N\$1.05-b on last year's N\$1.1-b revised expenditure, accounting for 7.7% of the N\$13.5-b procurement total in 2024/25.

On the other hand, 2024/25's procurement allocations include a 14.3% or N\$1.27-b-m increase in the acquisition of consumable materials, supplies, other services and expenses over last year's revised N\$7-b expenditure to N\$8.2-b, accounting for over 60% of the N\$13.5-b total.

Nevertheless, the 22% increase in this year's procurement budget is double the 11% increase in the overall budget to N\$99-b and includes notably higher allocations of 60% for procurement under the N\$9.5-b development budget to N\$5.46-b.

This year's 22% increase in budgeted procurement allocations is a welcome boost on 2023/24's revised expenditure of N\$11-b which had been a lower 12.6% increase on the previous year's N\$9.8-b.

This year's 42.45% in construction is almost double the 22% increase in the procurement budget as a whole and a welcome reversal on last year, when the N\$2.2-b revised expenditure on construction was 34.4% lower than 2022/23's N\$3.4-b.

The same applies to procurement under the development budget, where this year year's 60% increase to N\$5.46-b is a sharp reversal on 2023/24's revised expenditure of N\$3.4-b, which had been 18% less than 2022/23's actual N\$4.2-b procurement expenditure in the development budget.

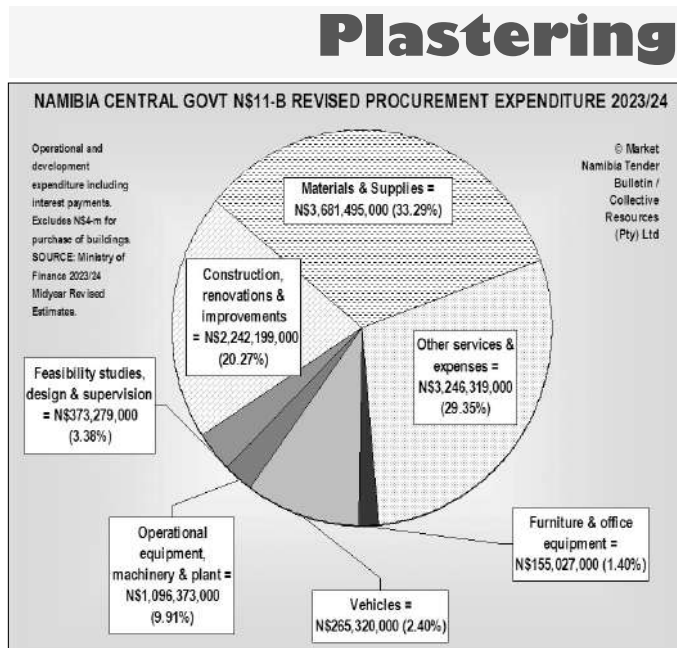
### Procurement spending heads

There are eight heads of procurement spending:

- \* Construction, renovations and improvements (CRI) and feasibility studies, design and supervision (FSDS) are both channelled entirely through the development budget.
- \* Expenditure on materials and supplies (M&S) and other services and expenses (OSE) are items of consumption spending, provided for mostly as part of current operational expenditure, but with some allocations channelled through the development budget to specific projects.
- \* Expenditure on operational equipment, machinery and plant (OEMP), furniture and office equipment (FOE) and vehicles (V) is classified as capital expenditure under the operational budget, with some allocations to specific development projects.
- \* Since 2019/20, the budget has itemized 'purchase of buildings' - as part of development expenditure.

### Materials and supplies

N\$4.4-b has been voted for materials and supplies (M&S) in 2024/25, accounting for the biggest, 32.8% of the N\$13.495-b procurement budget, following a N\$722.55-m or



19.6% increase on last year's revised N\$3.68-b expenditure when it accounted for 33.27% of the N\$11-b procurement total – also the biggest.

Last year's N\$3.68-b revised expenditure on materials and supplies had been a massive 59% or N\$1.365-b increase on 2022/23's actual N\$2.3-b expenditure when it accounted for 23.5% of the N\$9.8-b procurement total in third place behind construction's 34.7% in first place and the 28.57% employed by 'other services and expenses' in second place.

Materials and Supplies (M&S) expenditure relates to the acquisition of store items of a consumable utilized in the process of government services/operations, such as provisions, spares, stationery, cleaning and other materials.

M&S's N\$2.3-b actual expenditure

in 2022/23 was 2.3% or N\$54.5-m less than 2021/22's actual N\$2.37-b expenditure, accounting for 25.76% of the N\$9.2-b procurement total in third place behind other services and expenses in first place with 31.5% and construction's 29.3% in third place.

Last year's 59% increase in revised M&S expenditure over 2022/23's actual spending was by far the biggest over the past seven years since 2017/18, during which there were only two year-on-year decreases in spending on materials and supplies:

- \* by 20.58% or N\$404.5-m to N\$1.56-b in 2018/19 from the previous year's N\$1.965-b; and
- \* by 2.3% or N\$54.5-m in 2022/23 to N\$2.31-b from the previous year's N\$2.37-b.

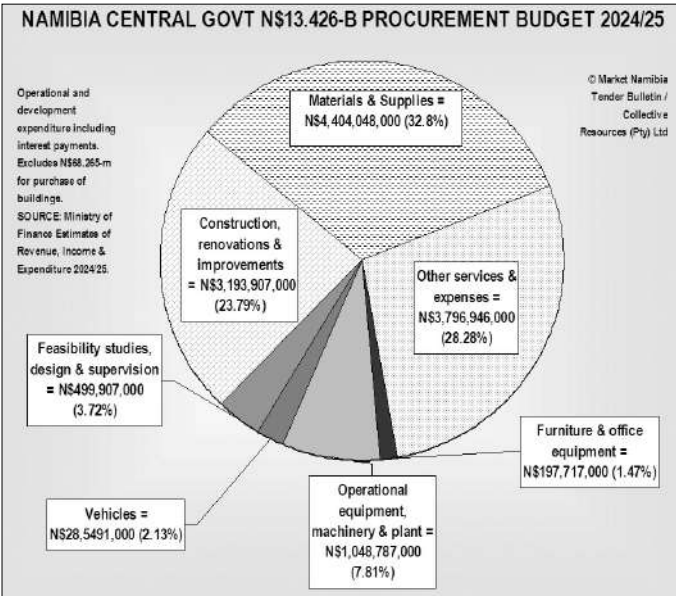

The N\$3.8-b set aside for other services and expenses in 2024/25 accounts for 28% of the N\$13.5-b procurement total in second place and is 17% or N\$550.6-m more than last year's revised N\$3.25-b expenditure, when it accounted for 29.5% – also in second place and ahead of construction.

finance minister, Ipumbu Shiimi.

This is perhaps not all that surprising, because 'other services and expenses' has earned itself the reputation of being government's 'slush fund' because it includes procuring goods and services for the gratification of the bureaucracy and the political elite.

Its biggest component by far, is consulting fees not relating to the construction sector - largely to compensate for the lack of governance capacity resulting from the ruling party's cadre deployment within the bureaucracy instead of appointing skilled technocrats.

## Construction, renovations and improvements

The N\$3.2-b voted in 2024/25 for construction, renovations and improvements (CRI) accounts for only 23.7% of the N\$13.5-b procurement budget in third place amongst eight procurement heads of expenditure and is the fourth-lowest over the past twelve years, during which only three years have had lower expenditure:

- \* 2023/24 with N\$2.24-b revised expenditure;
- \* 2021/22 with N\$2.78-b actual expenditure; and
- \* 2017/18 with N\$3.186-b actual expenditure.

The N\$2.446-b revised expenditure on construction, renovations and improvements in 2023/24 was the lowest in the past twelve years since 2013/14 and was only the second time that its ceiling dropped below N\$3-b.

Last year was also the first time that construction ranked in third place below both of the current procurement categories of 'materials and supplies' as well as 'other services and expenses' in the same year, although it has sometimes ranked below OSE in the past.

In 2024/25 construction is again ranked below both materials and supplies, whose N\$4.4-b accounts for 32.6% of the N\$13.5-b procurement total in first place amongst all eight procurement heads, and other services and expenses, whose N\$3.8-b allocation accounts for 28% in second place.

This is despite construction's 42.45% or N\$951.7-m increase over 2023/24's revised CRI expenditure compared to the 19.6% or N\$722.55-m increase in materials and supplies and the 17% or N\$550.6-m increase in the allocation for other services and expenses. But this year's bigger increase in the budget for CRI comes off a much lower base last year than those of M&S and OSE (see accompanying table).

In terms of 2023/24's revised expenditure, construction accounted for only 20.36% of the N\$11-b procurement total, which was even lower than this year's 23.7%.

In terms of 2022/23's actual expenditure, construction accounted for a much higher 34.7% of all N\$9.8-b procurement spending.

The only other year that construction expenditure dropped below N\$3-b was in 2021/22 when its actual N\$2.78-b was far below the N\$3.124-b allocated at the beginning of the year, before being cut back in those midyear revisions when funds were diverted away from development, construction and capital expenditure to prop up shortfalls in current consumption allocations.

This N\$2.78-b actual expenditure on construction in 2021/22 had been a 23.5% or N\$853.5-m reduction on 2020/21's N\$3.6-b actual expenditure – when it accounted for 32.4% of the N\$11.1-b procurement total – higher than the following year's 30.2% but below 2022/23's 36.6%.

## Construction's history of stagnation

Construction's actual N\$3.6-b expenditure in 2020/21 was 8.25% or N\$326.8-m below 2019/20's actual N\$3.96-b, when it accounted for over 42% of that year's N\$9.36-b procurement total – far short of this year's 23.7%.

The N\$3.2-b allocated for construction in 2024/25 is a little over half its N\$6.1-b peak in 2015/16.

Over the twelve years since 2013/14, expenditure on construction, renovations and improvements has remained virtually stagnant, with this year's N\$3.194-b only a hair's breadth above 2013/14's N\$3.186-b, peaking at N\$6.1-b in 2015/16.

During these past eleven year-on-year fluctuations, expenditure on construction has increased six times and declined five times.

The declines in actual construction expenditure were:

- \* by 21.3% to N\$4.8-b in 2016/17 from the previous year's N\$6.135-b – the highest CRI expenditure in the past twelve years;
- \* by 34% to 3.185-b in 2017/18 from the previous year's N\$4.83-b;
- \* by 8.25% to N\$3.6-b in 2020/21 from the previous year's N\$3.96-b;
- \* by 23.5% to N\$2.78-b in 2021/22 from the previous year's N\$3.6-b;
- \* by 35.4% to N\$2.24-b revised expenditure in 2023/24 from the previous year's N\$3.4-b.

No other procurement category has had as many year-on-year declines in expenditure as construction.

The six year-on-year increases in actual construction expenditure or allocations were:

- \* by 53% to N\$5.2-b in 2014/15 from the previous year's N\$3.4-b;

N\$1.965-b to 2022/23's N\$2.3-b.

Over these past eight years, expenditure on materials and supplies has exceeded expenditure on construction, renovations and improvements only once – in 2023/24 when its N\$3.68-b revised expenditure was more than construction's N\$2.24-b – a massive gap of N\$1.44-b.

Of the N\$4.4-b set aside for materials and supplies in 2024/25, N\$3.3-b or 75% is operational expenditure and a little over N\$1-b is channelled through the development budget for development projects.

## Other services & expenses

The ubiquitous 'other services and expenses' (OSE) has the second-biggest share of the procurement budget in 2024/25 but again behind materials and supplies as it was last year and ahead of construction, which lies third – as was the case last year.

The N\$3.8-b set aside for other services and expenses in 2024/25 accounts for 28% of the N\$13.5-b procurement total and is 17% or N\$550.6-m more than last year's revised N\$3.25-b expenditure, when it accounted for 29.5% of the N\$11-b total in second place behind M&S's N\$3.68-b with 33.45% and also ahead of construction's N\$2.2-b with only 20%.

The N\$2.8-b actual expenditure on OSE in 2022/23 was 2.6% or N\$75.878-m less than 2021/22's N\$2.89-b, accounting for 31.4% of the N\$9.2-b procurement total in second place behind construction's top spot with 35%, followed by M&S in third place with 23.5%.

OSE's N\$2.9-b actual expenditure in 2021/22 was a sharp 26.3% or N\$1-b decline on 2020/21's N\$3.9-b, when it accounted for 35% of the N\$11.1-b procurement total in first place ahead of construction's N\$3.6-b with a 32.7% share ranked second and M&S's N\$2.28-b with 20.7% in third place.

Its N\$3.9-b actual expenditure in 2020/21 was almost double – 92.6% more – than 2019/20's N\$2-b when it accounted for only 21.5% of the N\$9.36-b procurement total in third place behind construction's biggest, 4.6% share with N\$3.96-b and second-placed M&S with its N\$2-b accounting for 21.36% of the N\$9.36-b total.

Over the eight years since 2017/18, expenditure on other services and expenses has dipped only three times:

- \* by 46% or N\$1.77-b to N\$2.1-b in 2018/19 from the previous year's N\$3.86-b actual expenditure;
- \* by 2.3% or N\$48.3-m in 2019/20 to N\$2.04-b from the previous year's N\$2.08-b; and
- \* by 26.3% or N\$1.03-b to N\$2.9b in 2021/22 from the previous year's N\$3.9-b.

But overall, over the six years since 2017/18, actual OSE expenditure fell by 27.5% from N\$3.86-b in 2017/18 to 2022/23's N\$2.8-b, having peaked at N\$3.9-b in 2020/21 when it exceeded construction's N\$3.6-b.

Over the past eight years, OSE expenditure has exceeded construction expenditure in four:

- \* 2017/18 when its N\$3.86-b was more than construction's N\$3.2-b;
- \* 2020/21 when its N\$3.9-b was more than construction's N\$3.6-b;
- \* 2021/22 when its N\$2.9-b was more than construction's N\$2.78-b; and in
- \* 2023/24 when its N\$3.2-b revised expenditure exceeded construction's N\$2.2-b – the biggest gap to date.

Of the N\$3.8-b set aside for other services and expenses in 2024/25, N\$3.6-b or 95% is channelled through the operational budget and rest towards development projects.

## What is OSE?

Other services and expenses is a ubiquitous procurement spending head, most of which by far involves quotations outside the public domain:

- \* training courses, symposia and workshops;
  - \* printing and advertisements;
  - \* security contracts;
  - \* entertainment for politicians;
  - \* office refreshment or 'refreshment';
  - \* official entertainment and corporate gifts;
  - \* 'others' (predominantly non-consulting services such as maintenance and cleaning).
- Three new OSE spending subheads were added in 2019/20:
- \* sector research and mapping;
  - \* claims against the state; and
  - \* consultancy fees (outside the public construction sector).

This detailed breakdown of OSE spending heads was introduced under former finance minister, Calle Schlettwein's watch in the 2015/16 fiscal year, but was removed from detailed disclosure in 2020/21's budget by the new

The N\$3.2-b voted in 2024/25 for construction, renovations and improvements accounts for only 23.7% of the N\$13.5-b procurement budget in third place amongst eight procurement heads of expenditure and is the fourth-lowest over the past twelve years.

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In its usual fourth place, accounting for 7.77% of the N\$13.5-b procurement total in 2024/25, a little over N\$1.48-b has been voted for operational equipment, machinery and plant – exceeding N\$1-b for the second consecutive year, following a 4.34% or N\$47.586-m reduction on last year's N\$1.1-b revised expenditure.

## N\$68.265-m voted for purchase of buildings in

consecutive year. This follows a 4.34% or N\$47.586-m reduction on last year's N\$1.1-b revised expenditure, accounting for a higher 9.96% of the N\$11-b total - by far its biggest allocation over the past twelve years.

This followed a huge 42% or N\$325.3-m increase over 2022/23's N\$771-m actual expenditure, when it accounted for over 7.8% of the N\$9.8-b procurement total – also ranked fourth.

It had started 2022/23 with its first-ever allocation over N\$1-b, with a ceiling of N\$1.05-b before the midyear cutbacks resulted in N\$909-m, further

reduced to N\$771-m in that year's actual expenditure.

As a result, OEMP's actual expenditure in 2022/23 was 8% or N\$57-m more than 2021/22's actual N\$714-m.

This, in turn, had been 15.55% or N\$131.5-m below 2020/21's N\$845.4-m actual expenditure.

Over the six years since 2017/18, OEMP expenditure has fallen twice year-on-year:

\* by 4.3% or N\$38-m to N\$845.4-m in 2020/21 from the previous year's N\$883.46-m; and  
\* by 15.55% or N\$131.5-m to N\$714-m in 2021/22 from the previous year's N\$845.4-m.

Over the six years since 2017/18,

- \* by 18% to N\$6.135-b in 2015/16 from the previous year's N\$5.2-b;
- \* by 8.7% to N\$3.464-b in 2018/19 from the previous year's N\$3.186-b;
- \* by 14.3% to N\$3.96-b in 2019/20 from the previous year's N\$3.46-b;
- \* by 23% to N\$3.4-b in 2022/23 from the previous year's N\$2.78-b;
- \* by 42.45% to 2024/25's budgeted N\$3.2-b from last year's revised N\$2.24-b.

All construction expenditure is channelled through the development budget.

### Operational equipment, machinery and plant

In its usual fourth place, accounting for 7.77% of the N\$13.5-b procurement total in 2024/25, a little over N\$1.48-b has been voted for operational equipment, machinery and plant (OEMP) – exceeding N\$1-b for the second

## 2024/25 is 1,600% more than last year's N\$4-m

actual expenditure on OEMP grew by 57% from N\$490.7-m to N\$771-m in 2022/23. Of OEMP's N\$1.048-bb allocation in 2024/25, N\$700-m or 66.8% is channeled through the operational budget and N\$350-m is allocated towards development projects.

### Feasibility studies, design & supervision

A little below N\$500-m has been voted in 2024/25 for feasibility studies, design and supervision (FSDS) in its usual fifth place out of eight procurement heads, accounting for 3.7% of the N\$13.5-b procurement budget.

This is the highest FSDS budget over the past eight years but only the third highest over the past twelve years since 2013/14.

The N\$500-m voted for FSDS in 2024/25 follows a 34% or N\$126.6-m increase over last year's N\$373.3-m revised expenditure accounting for 3.4% of the N\$11-b procurement total.

This is more than the N\$354.6-m initially voted for feasibility studies, design & supervision in 2023/24 – its second-lowest allocation in the past eleven years since 2013/14.

Its N\$373.3-m revised expenditure last year was 21% or N\$64.5-m more than its actual N\$308.7-m expenditure in 2022/23 – by far its lowest over the twelve years since 2013/14.

The actual N\$308.7-m expenditure on FSDS in 2022/23 was over 22% or N\$87.6-m less than 2021/22's N\$396.4-m, which, in turn had been a 6.2% or N\$23-m increase on 2020/21's N\$373.2-m actual expenditure.

This had at the time been feasibility studies, design and supervision's lowest expenditure in the past eight years.

The N\$373-m actual expenditure in 2020/21 was less than half its all-time N\$749-m high in actual expenditure in 2015/16, when it accounted for 9.5% of that year's N\$7.9-b actual procurement total.

### Historical FSDS expenditure

Over the past twelve years since 2013/14, actual expenditure on feasibility studies, design and supervision has increased by 24.7% from N\$401-m in 2013/14 to this year's N\$500-m, peaking at N\$749-m in 2015/16 and recording its second-highest expenditure of N\$613.4-m in 2014/15.

But during that period FSDS expenditure fell four times year-on-year:

- \* by 47% or N\$351-m to N\$398-m in 2016/17 from the previous year's record N\$749-m – its biggest annual decline in expenditure;
- \* by 22% or N\$87-m to N\$311.6-m in 2017/18 from the previous year's N\$398-m;
- \* by almost 8% or N\$32.3-m to N\$373.2-m in 2020/21 from the previous year's N\$405.5-m; and
- \* by 2022/23's 22% or N\$87.6-m to N\$308.7-m - its lowest annual expenditure over the past twelve years since 2013/14.

With four year-on-year declines in expenditure since 2013/14, actual FSDS expenditure has increased seven times:

- \* by 53% or N\$212.5-m in 2014/15 from the previous year's N\$400.77-m;
- \* by 22% or N\$135.7-m to its record N\$749-m in 2015/16 from the previous year's N\$613.4-m;
- \* by 23.8% or N\$74-m to N\$385-m in 2018/19 from the previous year's N\$311-m;
- \* by 5.3% or N\$20.4-m to N\$405.5-m in 2019/19 from the previous year's N\$385-m;
- \* by 6% or N\$23-m to N\$396.4-m in 2021/22 from the previous year's N\$373.3-m;

In sixth and second-last place, N\$197.7-m has been voted for furniture and office equipment (including ICT) in 2024/25 – the highest in the past eight years, accounting for 1.46% of the N\$13.5-b procurement budget, following a N\$42.7-m or 27.5% increase over last year's revised N\$155-m expenditure.

- \* by 21% or N\$64.5-m to N\$373.3-m revised expenditure in 2023/24 from the previous year's all-time low of N\$308.7-m; and
- \* by 34% or N\$126.6-m in 2024/25 from last year's revised N\$373.3-m.

All FSDS expenditure is channeled through the development budget.

### Vehicles

After languishing near the bottom of the government's procurement spending priorities over recent years, the budget for acquiring new vehicles (V) has hit a multi-year high in 2024/25 with N\$285.5-m, accounting for a little over 2% of all N\$13.5-b voted procurement expenditure in third-last place following a 7.6% or N\$20.17-m increase over last year's N\$265.3-m revised spending when it accounted for 2.4% of the N\$11-b total – also ranked third-last and considerably more than the N\$210-m initially allocated at the beginning of 2023/24.

The N\$265.3-m spent on buying new wheels last year was a massive N\$246.34-m or 321.6% more than 2022/23's actual N\$76.6-m expenditure (after starting with a N\$54.5-m ceiling at the beginning of that year).

The N\$54.5-m initial budget for new vehicles in 2022/23 was an unprecedented 100% increase over 2021/22's nil expenditure from an initial 678.57% increase over N\$7-m that was subsequently all erased.

The actual N\$76.6-m spent on new vehicles in 2022/23 accounted for a

meagre 0.78% of that year's total N\$9.8-b procurement expenditure in second-last place, compared to 2020/21 when only N\$24-m was spent on acquiring new wheels, accounting for only 0.2% of the N\$11.1-b procurement total.

This, in turn, had been a 273.5% or N\$17.5-m increase over 2019/20's actual N\$6.4-m expenditure on vehicles accounting for 0.68% of actual N\$9.36-b procurement expenditure.

These wildly erratic fluctuations in expenditure on new vehicles were a walk in the park compared to the original budget allocations between 2019/20 and 2022/23, that were a series of bad jokes, with annual revised expenditures turning out to be far above successive under-allocations that were totally unrealistic in the first place.

At the beginning of 2021/22, we remarked that government officials must be scratching their heads over which car to buy with the paltry N\$500,000 budgeted for vehicle purchases – an 11% increase over 2020/21's revised N\$450,000, which was an even bigger joke, accounting for 0.01% of the procurement budget and the lowest ever.

As it turned out, 2020/21's actual expenditure on new vehicles turned out at N\$24-m - a far cry from the N\$450,000 after the original allocation was slashed midyear by 91% or N\$4.5-m from N\$4.95-m voted initially to N\$450,000.

At the beginning of 2020/21, the N\$4.95-m allocation for the procurement of vehicles had been a 2.44% reduction (N\$124,000) on 2019/20's revised N\$5-m at the time, which has since been restated as N\$6.4-m actual expenditure – a little over half the N\$10-m initially voted.

A little below N\$500-m has been voted in 2024/25 for feasibility studies, design and supervision in its usual fifth place out of eight procurement heads, accounting for 3.7% of the N\$13.5-b procurement budget - is the highest FSDS budget over the past eight years following a 34% or N\$126.6-m increase over last year's N\$373.3-m revised expenditure.

The laughable N\$500,000 allocated at the beginning of 2021/22 turned into a big fat zero in actual expenditure.

During the six years between 2017/18 and 2022/23, actual expenditure on the acquisition of new vehicles rose 245.6% from N\$22.16-m N\$76.6-m in 2022/23, during which it fell twice:

- \* by 87.25% to N\$2.8-m in 2018/19 from the previous year's N\$22.164-m; and
- \* by 100% to N\$0 in 2021/22 from the previous year's N\$23.9-m.

Over the past seven years, actual expenditure on new vehicles fell from N\$22.164-m in 2017/18 to nil in 2020/21, recovering to N\$24-m in 2020/21, before increasing to 2022/23's N\$76.6-m.

It then almost quadrupled to this year's N\$285.5-m allocation, of which N\$245-m or almost 86% is operational expenditure and the remainder channeled through the development budget.

### Furniture & office equipment

In sixth and second-last place, N\$197.7-m has been voted for furniture and office equipment (including ICT) in 2024/25 – the highest in the past eight years, accounting for 1.46% of the N\$13.5-b procurement budget, following a N\$42.7-m or 27.5% increase over last

year's revised N\$155-m expenditure on FOE, when it accounted for a similar 1.4% of N\$11-b revised procurement spending in 2023/24.

Last year's N\$155-m revised FOE spending was more than the N\$142.576-m initially voted and translates later a 37% or N\$41.8-m increase over 2022/23's actual N\$113.2-m expenditure, which, in turn, was more than the N\$78.75-m voted at the beginning of 2022/23.

The N\$113.2-m actual expenditure on FOE in 2022/23 had been an enormous 126.4% or N\$63-m increase over 2021/22's actual N\$50-m expenditure.

The actual expenditure on FOE in 2021/22 was 27% or N\$18.4-m less than 2020/21's N\$68.4-m, consuming 0.6% of the N\$11.1-b procurement total.

Between 2017/18 and 2022/23, actual expenditure on furniture and office equipment rose by 44.75% from N\$78.2-m to N\$113.2-m, falling twice: \* by 47.36% to N\$41.17-m in 2018/19 from the previous year's N\$78.2-m; and

\* by 27% to N\$50-m in 2021/22 from the previous year's N\$68.4-m.

Of 2024/25's N\$197.7-m budget for furniture and office equipment, slightly over N\$141-m or 71% is operational expenditure and the remainder allocated to development projects.

### Purchase of buildings

N\$68.265-m has been voted for the purchase of buildings, accounting for 0.5% of the N\$13.5-b procurement budget in 2024/25, following a colossal N\$64.265-m or 1,606% increase on last year's N\$4-m expenditure – double the N\$2-m initially voted.

The N\$4-m revised expenditure on the purchase of buildings in 2023/24 was 100% more than the nil actual expenditure recorded for 2022/23 after N\$1.1-m had initially been voted – also a 100% increase on 2021/22's nil actual expenditure, after N\$2-m had been initially voted.

Nothing was spent on the purchase of buildings in 2020/21 either from the N\$35.6-m originally allocated.

Actual expenditure in 2019/20 is now stated as a token N\$274,382 – from N\$3-m initially voted.

N\$3.096-m voted for the purchase of buildings at the beginning of 2020/21 was increased dramatically by N\$20.4-m or 659% to N\$23.5-m midyear, since restated as nil actual expenditure.

Its allocation at the beginning of 2020/21 had been a whimsical N\$96,000 more than 2019/20's revised N\$3-m – now restated as N\$274,382 actual expenditure.

N\$81.5-m was actually spent on the purchase of buildings in 2017/18 – the highest to date at the time, falling to nil in 2021/22, with two other years of nil expenditure.

Purchase of buildings is all part of the development budget.

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# RE-AWARDS AFFECT N\$562-M ROAD MAINTENANCE CONTRACTS

28 JUNE 2024

The Central Procurement Board has re-awarded two gravel road maintenance tenders in the Road Authority's Keetmanshoop region reserved for SME contractors that had closed in 2022 worth N\$562-m – one as a result of a High Court order and the other because a contractor had defaulted.

In one case, the Central Procurement Board on 29-May-24 announced the re-award of a tender for nine SME Keetmanshoop sub-contracts that it had issued on behalf of the Roads Authority in 2022, stating that: "This Notice of Award follows the High Court order dated 15-Apr-24".

Although the notice published in *New Era* on 11-Jun-24 says "For more details, please log on to: www.cpbm.com.na", no further explanation could be found why the same companies were successful for the SME contract without any price changes.

In the other case, the CPB announced on 31-May-24 via a notice published in *New Era* on 11-Jun-24 that a change was made on the development contract for blading of gravel roads for the Roads Authority in Keetmanshoop, stating "This follows the failure of the previous awarded bidder in terms of Regulation 38(4) read together with Section 55(7) of the PPA".

Tender Bulletin 1517 listed the awards of both tenders for the blading of gravel roads in the Keetmanshoop

maintenance region totaling N\$551.7-m on 10-Nov-23.

## Same nine SME Keetmanshoop sub-contracts re-awarded at unchanged prices

W/OAB/CPBN-03/2022: Procurement of nominated SME sub-contracts for the blading of gravel roads in the Keetmanshoop Region closed 28-Sep-22 with 82 offers. This tender was advertised in Jul-22 as W/OAB/CPBN-09/2022 but had a different reference number in the CPB award notice.

Bids were published in *Bulletin 1465*. Tenderers had to state their prices for nine road sections: NC-KHP-14, NC-KHP-06, NC-KHP-28, NC-KHP-29, NC-KHP-22, NC-KHP-19, NC-KHP-15, NC-KHP-17 and NC-KHP-03.
